

# CALL FOR PAPERS

## the 5<sup>th</sup> AAAH Annual Conference

The Asia-Pacific Action Alliance on Human Resources for Health (AAAH) is organizing the 5<sup>th</sup> AAAH conference in 4-6 October 2010, in Bali, Indonesia. The theme of this Conference will be **“HRH Challenges for Achieving MDGs”**

The Conference aims to address and discuss HRH challenges to achieving MDGs and provide input to the planning for the 2nd Global Forum which will be held in January 2011 in Bangkok, Thailand.

### PARTICIPATION

The participants will be drawn from 15 AAAH member countries, and from different African / Asian countries. A minimum of 2-3 participants per AAAH member country, depending on budget availability, are expected to attend and representatives from about 8-10 African countries.

From each country/region a multi-stakeholder team will participate, which may include various interest groups such as the Ministry of Health, professionals, academia, government, non government organizations, and the private sector. It is anticipated that around 150 participants will attend the conference.
