Objectives of the workshop

This CCF institutions capacity building meeting will bring together Ministries of Health, training or research institutions and partners to validate the CCF capacity building process, design capacity building actions for CCF stakeholders, and introduce capacity building tools (HAF, advocacy and RRT).

The specific objectives are to:

- Identify CCF core competencies related to the HRH committees, the HRH implementation process and the HRH plan monitoring and evaluation process
- Define institutions' roles for accelerating the CCF process
- Identify institutions' needs for CCF capacity building
- Develop national CCF capacity building action plan in order to strengthen HRH coordination processes
- Establish mechanism for collaboration between national institutions and HRH committee

Participants

To ensure that key stakeholders are involved in the CCF capacity building process the Alliance will bring together Ministries of Health HRH focal persons, national and regional capacity building institution representatives and partners. Participants will be drawn from AFRO (Cameroon, Comoros, Eritrea, Mali, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Zambia, Zimbabwe); AMRO/PAHO (El Salvador, Paraguay, Peru); EMRO (Afghanistan, Morocco, Pakistan) and SEARO/WPRO (Indonesia, Nepal, Papua New Guinea).
